



## Lingmell River Naturalisation National Trust

**completed:** Ongoing

**approx. project value:** Undisclosed

Bea Landscape Design were commissioned by Haycock Associates in 2007 to assist in the design and project management of a new bridge to cross Lingmell Beck at the head of the Wasdale Valley in the Lake District National Park.

Located with an SSSI on the edge of the Wastwater SAC, the bridge design was developed to enable the naturalization of the river channel, to reduce localized flooding of the adjacent National Trust campsite and to improve the long term geomorphology and ecology of the beck.

### Scope of work:

**Landscape consultant:** situated within an area voted as the nations favourite view, at the bottom of Scafell Pike, the project involved public engagement and detailed consultation with the Lake District National Park, Environment Agency and Natural England including the preparation of a Construction Method Statement, Ecological Assessment and Tree Survey.

**Project Management:** this role has included the appointment of the project engineer and quantity surveyor, the resolution of issues as the chair of design team meetings involving professional consultants and National Trust advisors and the carrying out of consultations with English Nature, the Environment Agency and the National Park. Other responsibilities include project programming and initial contract administration.

**Expert Witness:** the preparation photomontages as part of an Landscape Character and Visual Impact Assessment and witness statement to support the successful planning appeal.
