## New Zealand War Memorial Hyde Park Corner

The project is based around the setting of sixteen individual bronze sculptures or 'standards' with stone plinths on a shaped landscape mound to the northeast end of Hyde Park Corner. The standards consist of cross shaped vertical elements adorned with castings reminiscent of New Zealand and the relationship with Britain during and since the World Wars

### Scope of work:

**Lead consultant:** as landscape architects Bea Landscape Design where tasked with preparing detailed design drawings and specifications for planning approval and construction, liaising with the project architects and English Heritage to obtain the necessary consents.

**Project Management:** the commission included for the appointment of the project quantity surveyor and engineer, the resolution of issues as chair of the design team meetings involving professional consultants, client representatives and English Heritage. Other responsibilities included project programming, contract administration and site inspections.

### Programme.

Bea were commissioned in February 2006 and the project was completed in November 2006 in time for its official opening by HRM Queen Elizabeth II on Armistice Day, 2006.
