The phased environmental enhancement of the town centre for Lichfield District Council and Staffordshire County Highways Department including highway traffic calming measures, public areas and shop frontages including bespoke timber features and specialist road surfacing.

Bea Landscape Design supported by URS Corporation and Thomas Johnson were awarded the contract to develop the original sketch design to an acceptable standard for the Highways authority and town centre shop owners. The project also included liaising closely with Staffordshire County Highways to obtain the necessary Traffic Regulation Orders and agreements.

Project Management: as the councils representative the commission included the chairing of design team and progress meetings comprising professional consultants, highways and town council representatives. Other responsibilities include project programming, contract administration and site inspections and public liaison.
